
# TOWER VIEW NEWS

Sadly, I need to start the term with some sad news. Jackson, one of the much loved guinea pigs in Reception, became very poorly and had to be put down.


Due to his age, all children in school that started with us in Reception would have been in Reception class with Jackson. We are talking to the children to decide on a suitable memorial to remember him.

# Attendance Reminder

Children are expected to attend school every day unless ill.

## Why the change?

The current hours are short of the expected 32.5hours per week.

More time to teach the curriculum with 5 full afternoons per week.

Consistency for children, parents and staff across the week.

The large numbers of children in the OOSC on Fridays.

Pre-school need to be open 5 full days until 3:15pm to be able to offer the hours they are required to.

### Why the chosen timings?

3:20 finish gives time for parents to collect from pre-school and then get to other areas of school.

Starting earlier would be a challenge for all!

Informal feedback I've had from parents on the 3:30pm finish has not been positive.

Informal feedback I've had from parents on the 2pm has not been positive

Fulfills the expectation of school being open for 32.5hours per week.

8:50 – Register taken – school day starts – arrival in class after this time will result in children being marked late

8:55 – Learning starts
