Pre School News.

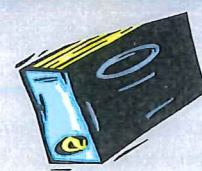
All summer birth children will have a letter about transition days next half term—please ask in mini movers if you have not had yours. Information will soon be given out about fees increase in Jan 2018.
