Dear Parents

Over the next few weeks we will be discussing road safety and being safe around coming to and from school, as it is Road Safety Week starting on Monday 20th November. It is really important that children and parents work together to ensure everyone is safe in and around roads, especially with the earlier dark nights. More information can be seen via our website links. However here are just a few statistics about road safety from 2016 in England:

- 5 people were killed on English roads everyday (1,792 last year!)
- 66 people were seriously injured on English roads everyday (24,101 last year!)
- 69 children were killed around schools last year in England.
- 46% of accidents involved cars and 25% pedestrians.

In the East Midlands area deaths rose by 10%

Therefore it is everyone's responsibility to protect everyone else be it when walking, riding or driving. I'm aware of the difficulties in and around school and I can only ask people to park further away from school gates and walk or if you live close enough just walk...it is great for your health. I hope you will try some of the links at home and perhaps talk to your child about road safety.

Finally good luck to all those who are going to Chasewater next week on the year 4 residential visit.

All the staff going are really looking forward to climbing, "Bear-Grilling", orienteering and enjoying the outdoors. I'm sure everyone will have great fun.

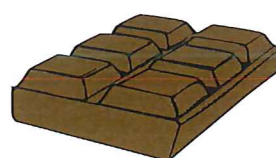
