Flu Vaccine—2nd visit

The School Age Immunisation Team have arranged a 2nd visit to Tower View on: **Tuesday 29th November 2022**

If you previously completed a consent form, but your child missed their vaccination due to absence etc. you DO NOT need to complete another form.

However if you did not complete a consent form for the original date then please complete one using guidance below.

If you have already consented for your child to receive this vaccination, but have since taken them to your GP please contact a member of the Immunisation Service on 0300 124 0366 Monday – Friday 8.30 – 4pm so that your child's consent form can be withdrawn.

Please make sure that you complete and submit your child's consent form as soon as you get it, whether you wish your child to be vaccinated or not and **only submit one consent form per child**.

Consents Forms need to be completed by 22nd November 2022, as we are unable to accept them after this date. You may be required to bring your child to a community clinic for a catch-up appointment, if you do not submit the consent form by the required date above as this will be the final visit to your child's school
