The support scheme for families who are struggling due to the current cost of living crisis has re-opened for the second half of the financial year. We know that the cost of living is affecting many families and households including those not entitled to benefits. This government scheme supports families that may need some extra help during these times.

This would mean you would be able to receive supermarket e-vouchers for £65 plus an extra £20 per child.

If you would be interested in a slow cooker (and have not had one through this scheme before) - again - let me know via the e mail address above.


## **PTFA Christmas Event**
