Household Support Fund

The support scheme for families who are struggling due to the current cost of living crisis has re-opened for the second half of the financial year. We know that the cost of living is affecting many families and households including those not entitled to benefits. This government scheme supports families that may need some extra help during these times.

School is able to nominate families and would like to be able to do this for you if you feel that this would help your family.

This would mean you would be able to receive supermarket e-vouchers for £65 plus an extra £20 per child.

Please do not worry about asking for help. The money has been allocated to this scheme and it is important that we use it and make sure we are helping our families.
