Swimming:

We are really excited to have the swimming pool now up and full of water on the KS2 playground.

Swimming is an important part of PE in the National Curriculum—which is why all school must ensure that all children have the opportunity to learn to swim—and keep themselves safe around water.

All children from Year 3-Year 6 will have some time in the pool. Each child's session will be 30minutes at a time.

Starting Monday 16th January for 3 weeks:

Year 6 will swim every day Monday-Thursday

Year 5 will swim every day Monday- Thursday

4RN will swim Monday, Wednesday Friday

4CW will swim Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

Year 3 will swim Fridays

We plan to have the pool every year to build on what the children learn year on year.

What will my child need?

Each day they swim your child will need.

Swimming costume

Towel

Goggles (optional)

Swimming hat (if your child has long hair)

No earrings can be worn on swimming days (or these must be taken out.)

Bear in mind if you child swims most days you will need to rinse/ wash the kit prior to the next day.

Children may wear PE kits on swimming days—and may wear their kit under their clothes (but bringing underwear to change into!)

Uniform

The governors have agreed a new uniform policy for the school. This comes into full effect in September, however, in case you are making decisions buying school/ PE clothing/ footwear as you child grows out of things, I wanted you to be aware of the changes now.

Overview of changes:

PE to be worn on PE days—no PE kit to be stored in school. This takes effect from w/c 16th January—your child will bring home their PE kit this Friday.

A PE 'uniform' so children still look part of the school on their PE days.

Children may wear black shoes or trainers daily.

The new uniform expectations are:

Our dress code encourages children's pride in their appearance and to increase their feeling of belonging to a caring school. Summer uniform is from Easter to October half term. Children should come to school dressed in accordance with the code below:

WINTER

White shirt/ blouse or white or light blue polo shirt

Charcoal grey/ black trousers/ skirt or pinafore dress

Royal blue school jumper/ cardigan

With skirt/ dress - grey or black tights or white socks

Black shoes or trainers

SUMMER – optional changes

Charcoal grey shorts instead of trousers

blue/ white checked gingham dresses can be worn in place of a skirt/ pinafore dress

PE Days

White t shirt (or plain t shirt in house colour)

Plain black shorts or joggers/ PE leggings/ tracksuit trousers

Trainers or plimsols

A plain royal blue hoodie/ sweatshirt may also be worn – or a school jumper/ cardigan.
